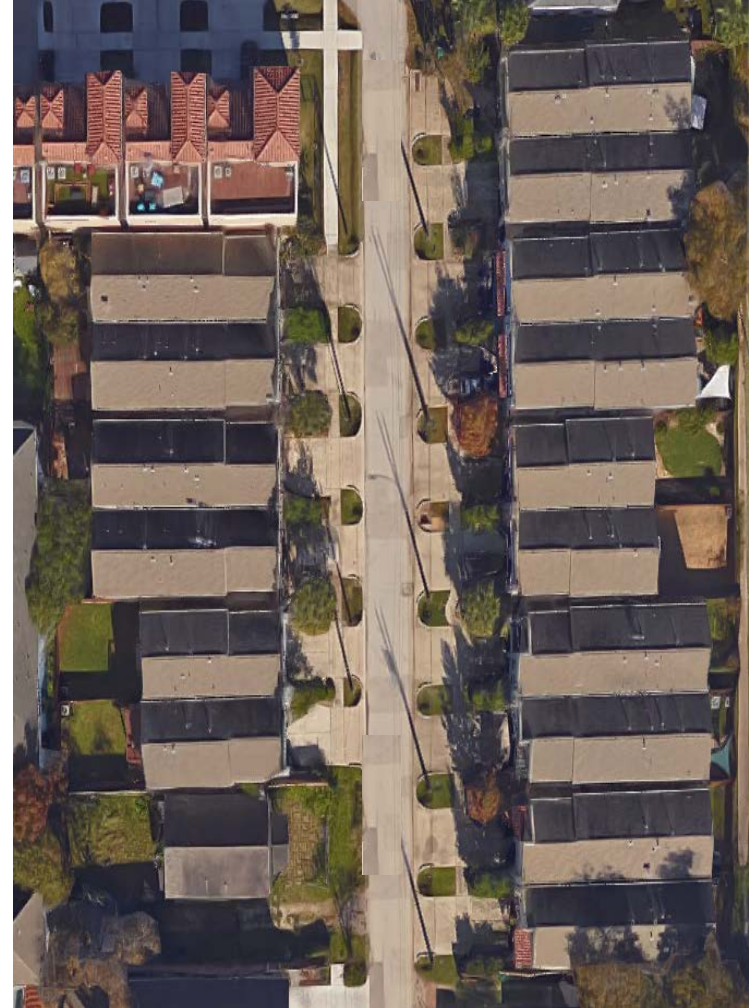

- HISD Pick-up/drop-off location

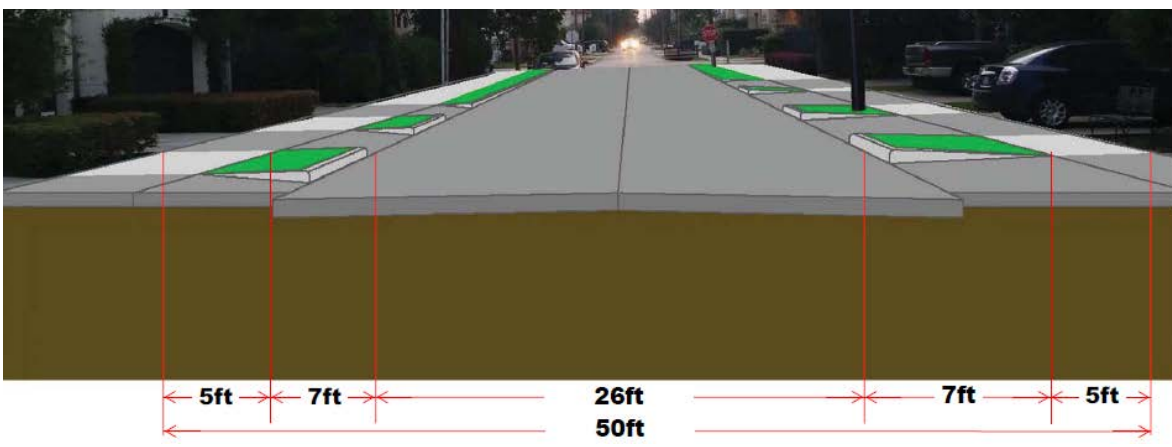

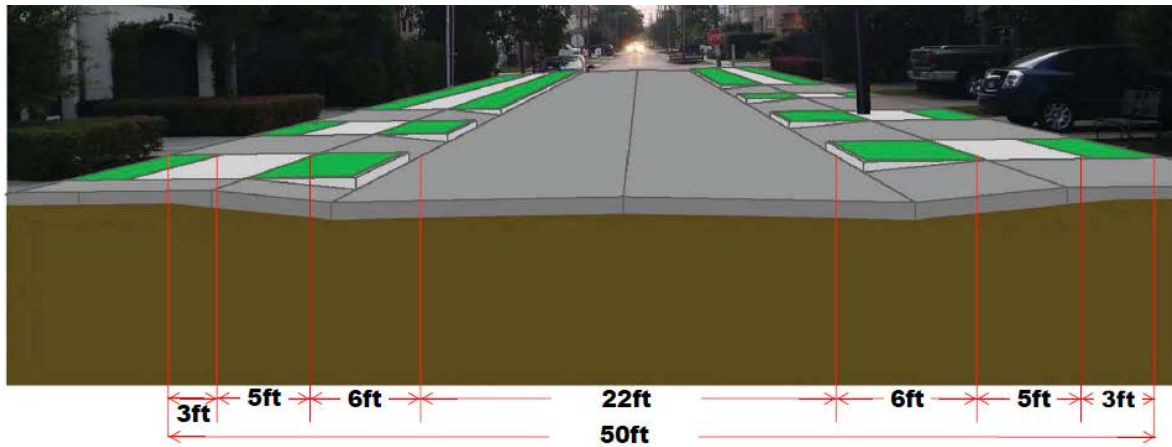

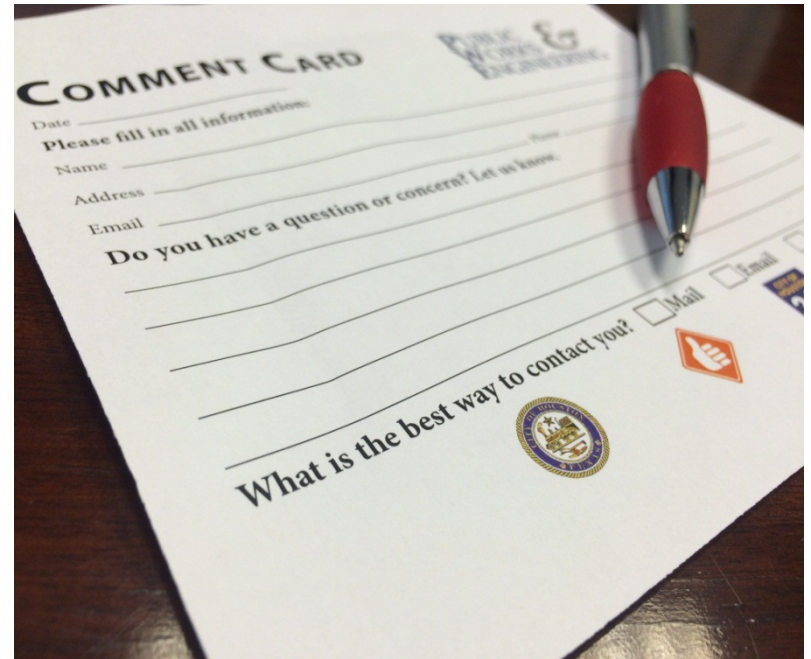
