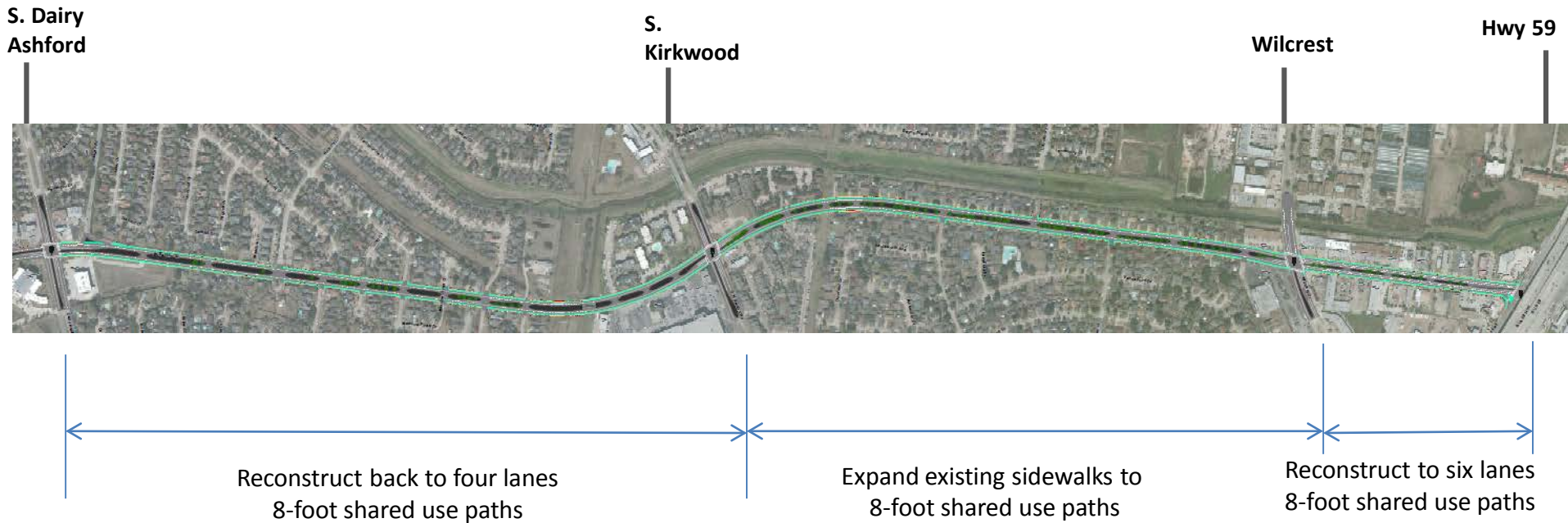

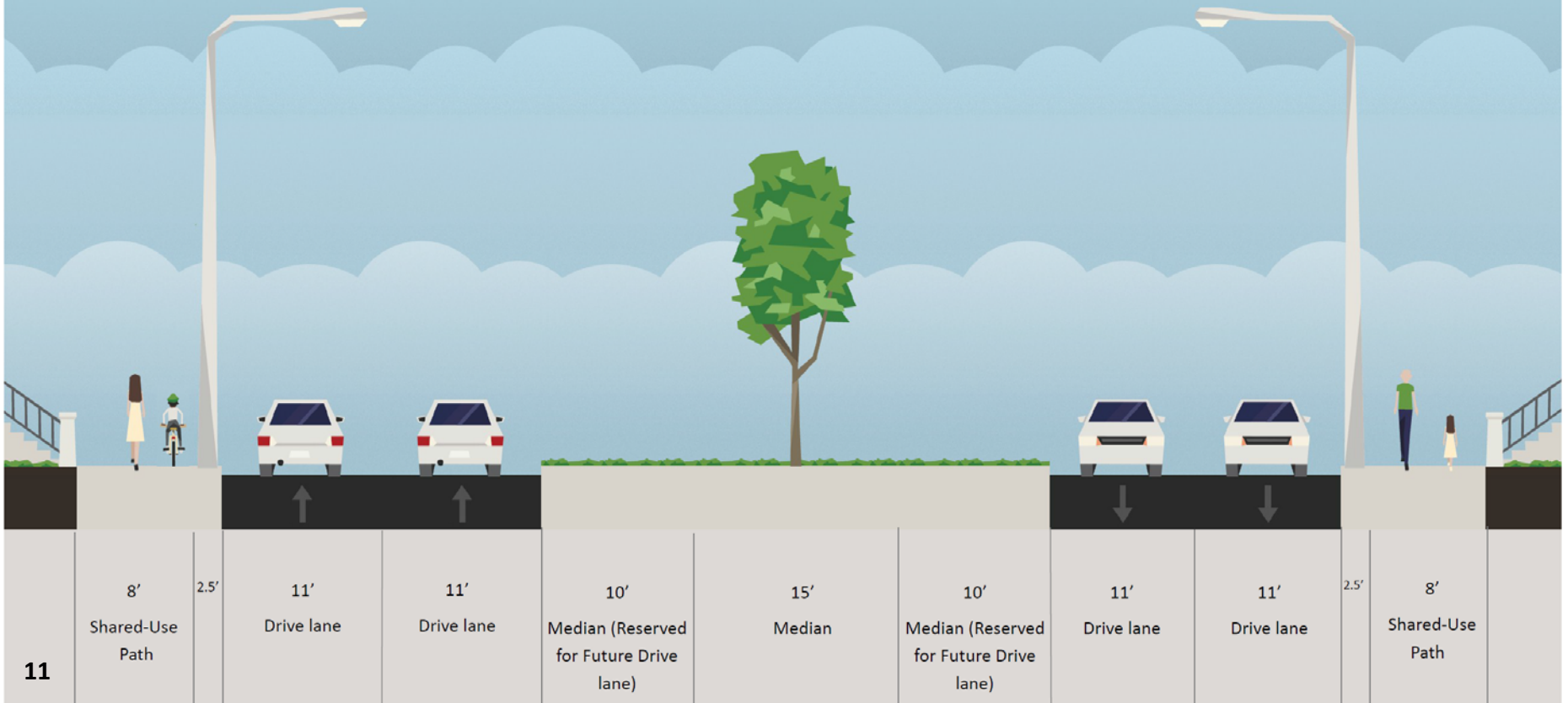

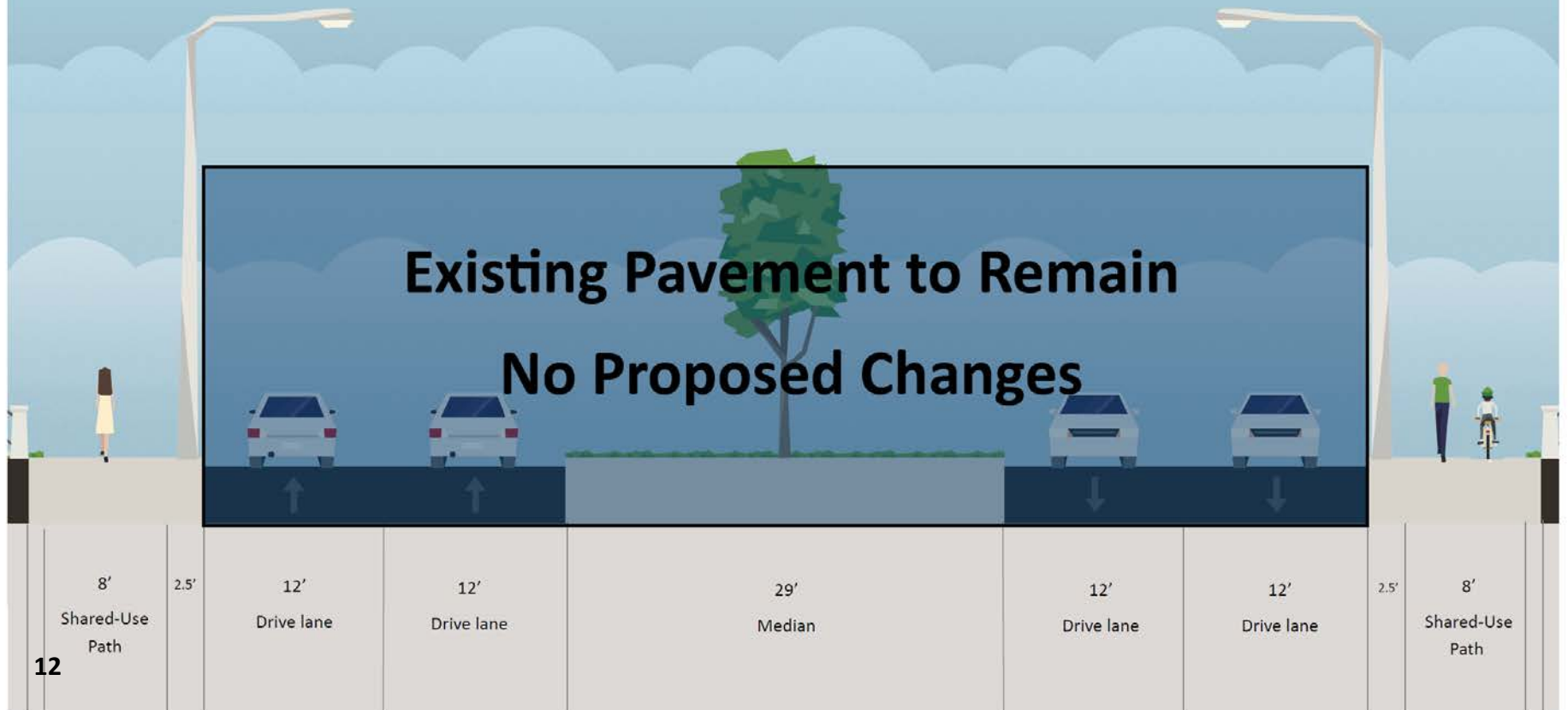



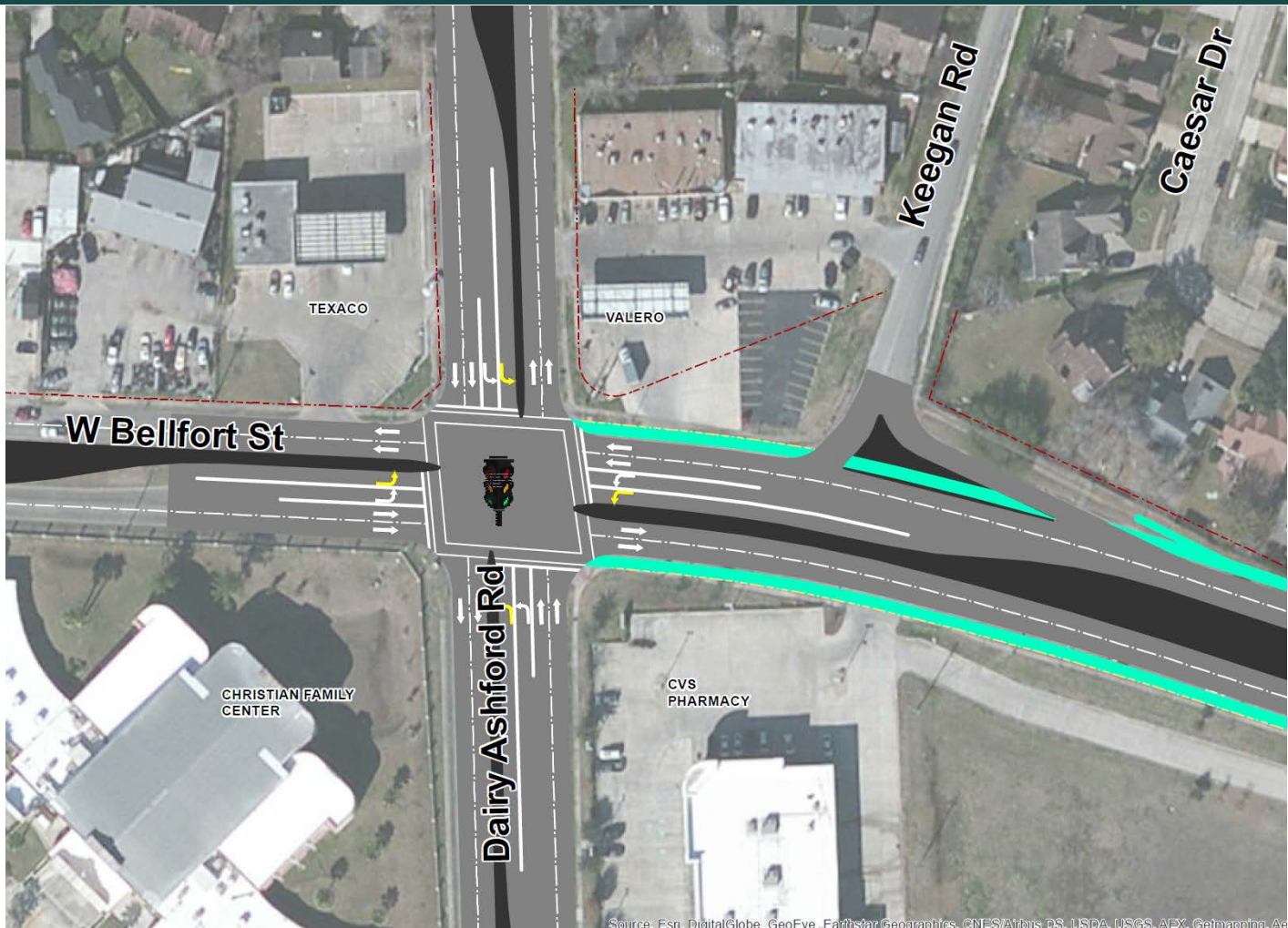


West Belfort at South Dairy Ashford Intersection



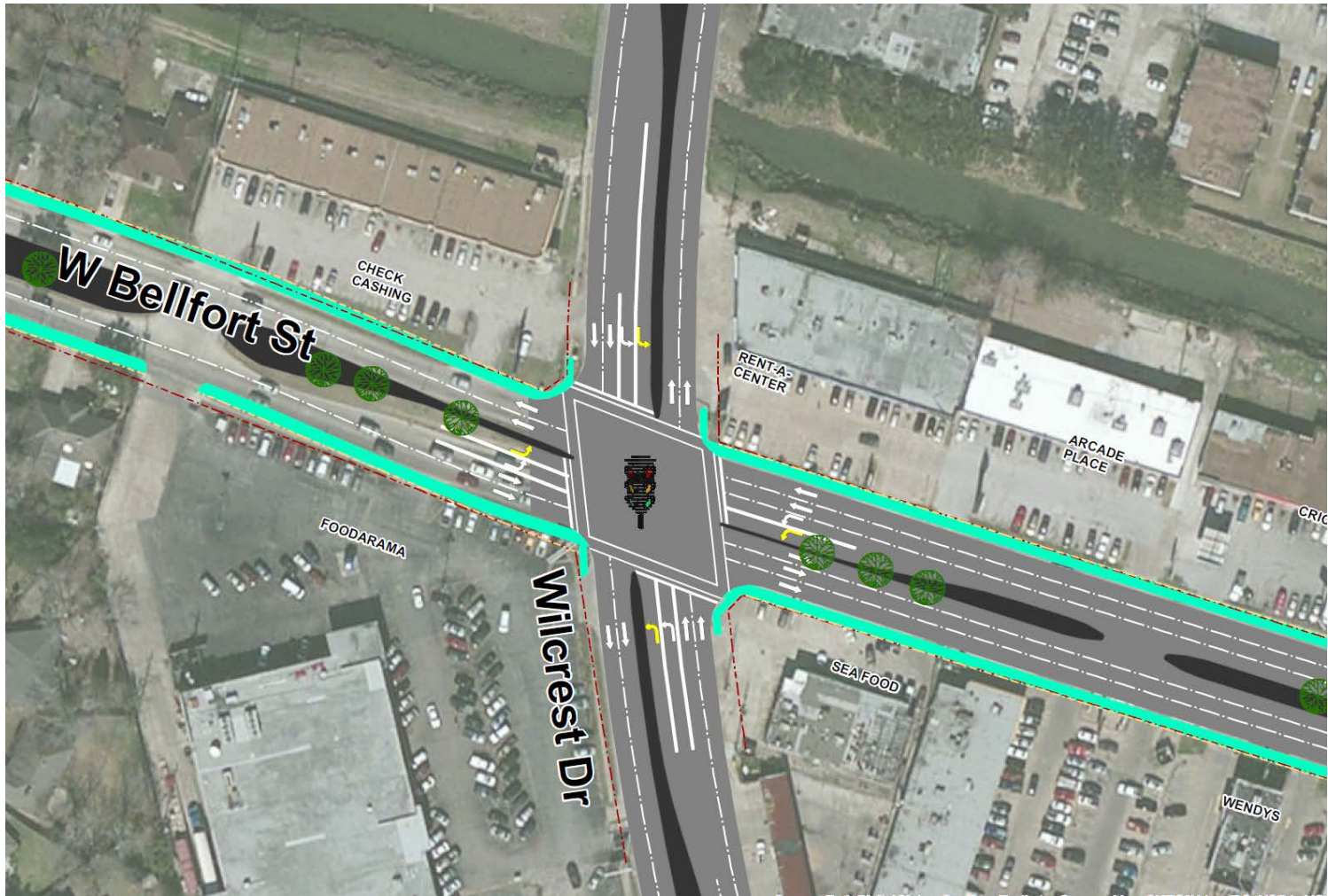

West Belfort at Wilcrest Intersection



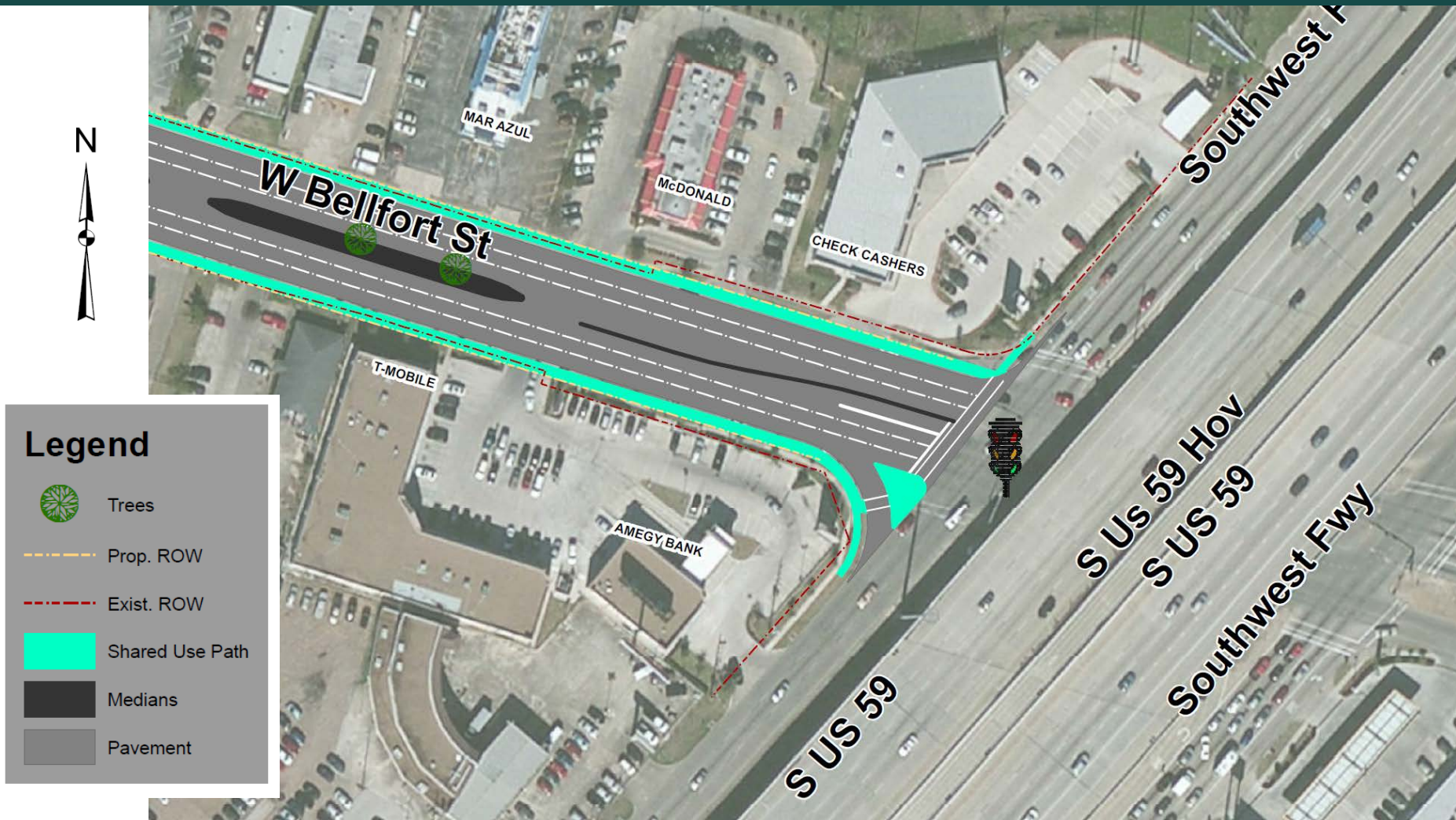

West Belfort Corridor- Proposed



Reconstruct existing road to 6 lanes between Wilcrest and Hwy 59, Reconstruct S. Dairy Ashford to S. Kirkwood to 4 lanes



Improved signals and turn lanes at intersections



Replace storm, water and sewer systems as necessary



Improve pedestrian realm



Add off street shared use paths
