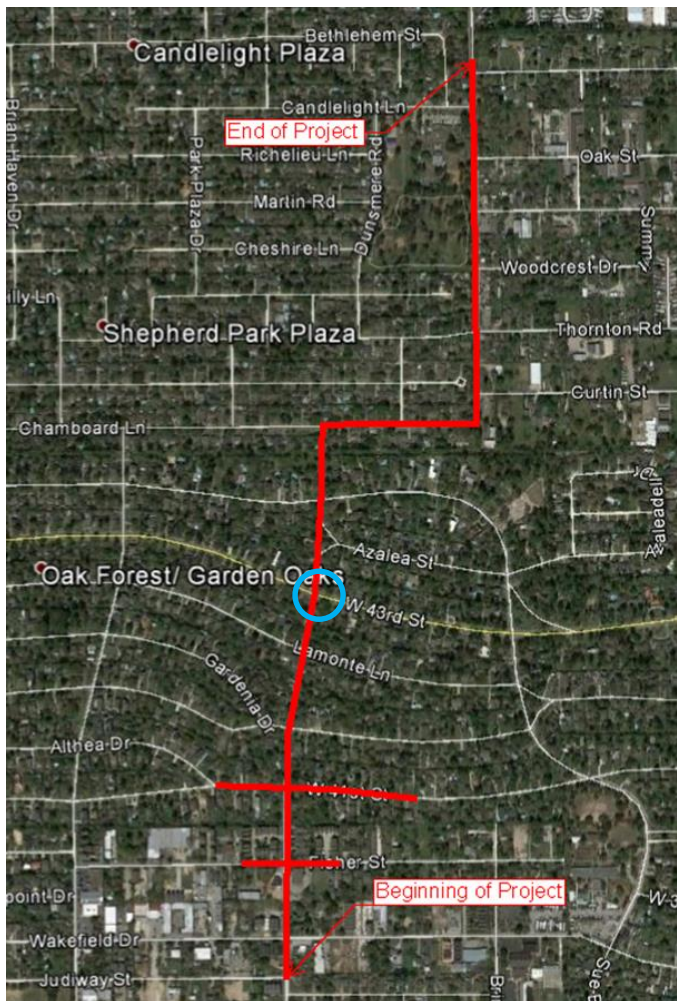

## Project Scope and Overview



Project Limits – Janisch Road to the North, Judiway Street to the South, North Shepherd Drive to the East, and Ella Boulevard to the West

- **Start Construction = October 10, 2016**
- **Anticipated Completion Date = July 7, 2018**
- **Construction Cost = \$19,658,776.00**

Installation of drainage and associated pavement including:

- Storm Sewer
- Sidewalks
- Curb ramps
- Underground utilities
  - Water Lines
  - Sanitary sewer lines
- Traffic Signal (blue circle)
- Street lighting



**Project length = 1.3 miles**
