
The project will improve approximately 1.5 miles of TC Jester Boulevard between Washington Avenue and Timbergrove Lane. The improvements include new pavement, improved intersections, new bicycle lanes, and upgraded storm drainage, water & sewer infrastructure.

SIDEWALK RECONSTRUCTION AND NEW PAVEMENT MARKINGS




TC JESTER AND WASHINGTON INTERSECTION

An improved roadway configuration at the intersection of TC Jester and Washington will add bicycle lanes and add left-turn bays at the median opening to the north.




TC JESTER AND IH 10 INTERSECTIONS

A new roadway configuration at the intersections of TC Jester and IH 10 will add bicycle lanes and balance the northbound and southbound through lanes while maintaining appropriate left-turn storage lengths.



TC JESTER AND LARKIN INTERSECTION

A new roadway configuration at the intersection of TC Jester and Larkin will provide new left-turn bays on all approaches. New median configuration will eliminate left turns from Cornish and Darling. This will allow improved “pedestrian refuge” at Cornish improving through traffic on TC Jester. Motorist would use an improved TC Jester and Larkin intersection to access Cornish and Darling via Radcliffe and Detering.



TC JESTER AND WEST 11th INTERSECTION

Median nose on the north approach will be modified to become accessible pedestrian crossing as part of the new signal equipment installation.
