## ADDRESSING DRAINAGE, MOBILITY, AND SAFETY

This Capital Improvement Plan drainage project is funded and starting design in 2016 with construction tentatively planned for 2020 for Phase 1 and 2022 for Phase 2. Reconstruction will include the upgrading of the underground storm drainage and reconstructing the roadway, water and sewer lines. Per design standards, a 5-foot sidewalk will be included on all streets.



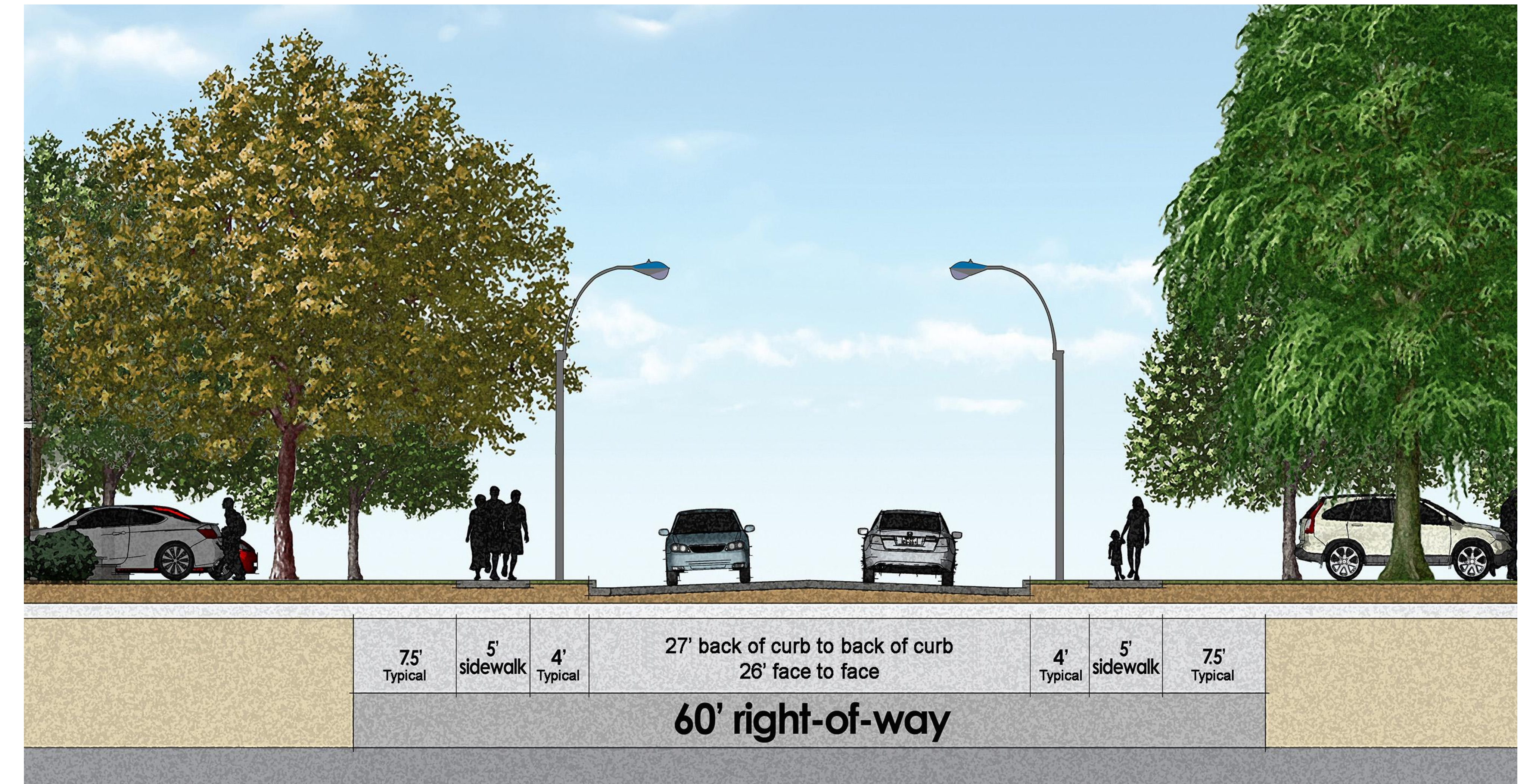
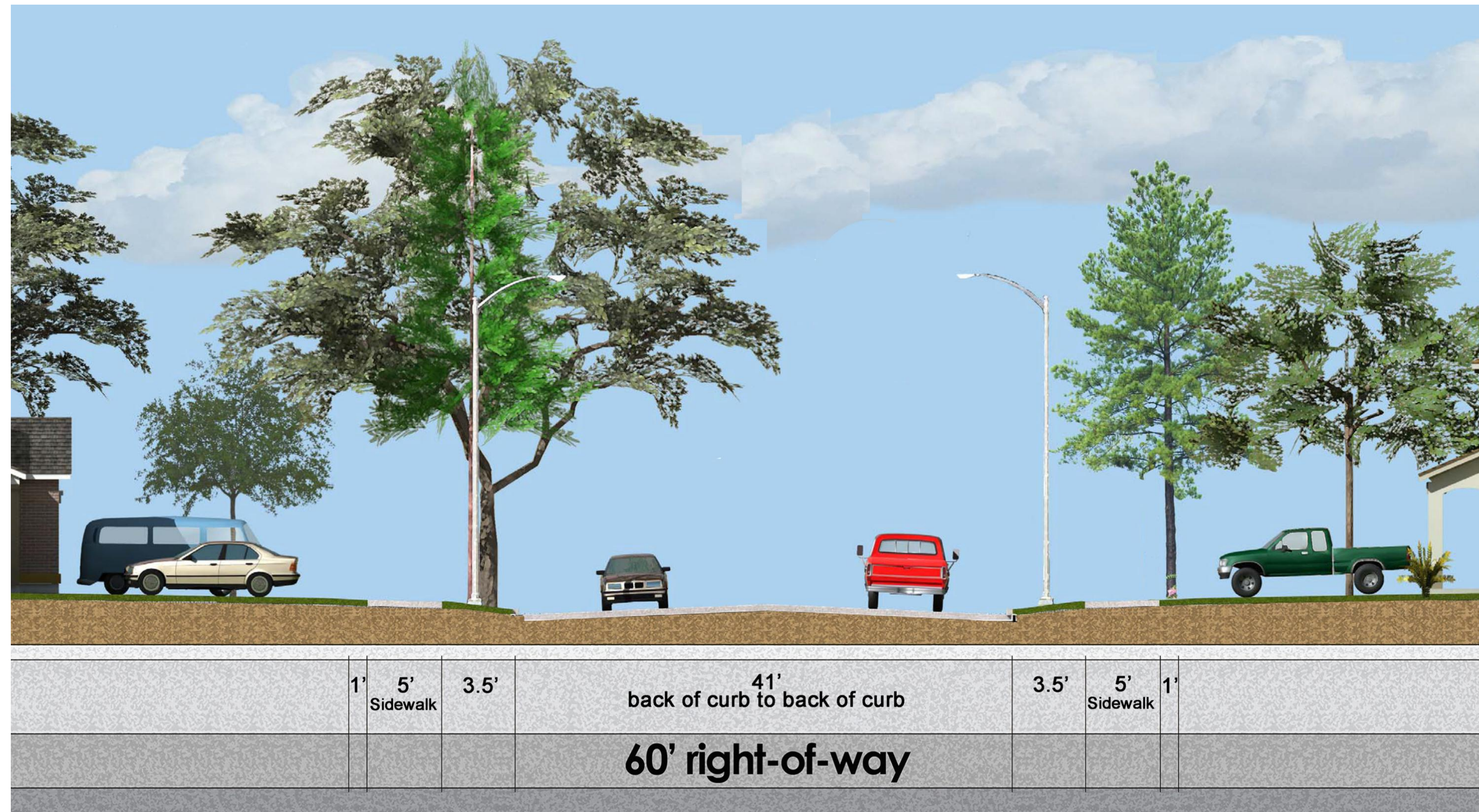
