
# BROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION



## **INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 45 TO GALVESTON ROAD**


The project will improve approximately 1.7 miles of Broadway Street from Interstate Highway 45 to Galveston Road. The improvements include new roadway and sidewalk pavement, improved intersections, upgraded drainage, water & sanitary infrastructure (where applicable), and a new railroad grade crossing.





# **IH-45 to HARTFORD**

This segment features wider medians and sidewalk, new left-turn lanes at Hartford, new signals at Hartford, and wheelchair ramps at every intersection.



#### HARTFORD to IH-610

This segment features wider medians, new left-turn lanes at medians, a wider sidewalk, and wheelchair ramps at every intersection.



## IH-610 to GALVESTON

This segment features new medians and sidewalk, new signals at Galveston Road, and a new railroad pedestrian/bike crossing.
