

COTTAGE GROVE STUDY AREA



Currently in the planning phase and not funded in the CIP, this study area is bounded by railroad tracks on the north, White Oak Bayou/North Shepherd on the east, I-10 on the south, and railroad tracks and Kansas St. on the west. A planning study conducted of the area identified, inadequate storm pipe sizes, and insufficient inlets. Although the need was identified based on storm features, streets, water and sanitary systems were also evaluated. The streets were found to be in poor to average condition and have insufficient right-of-way to meet current design standards. The water and sanitary evaluation identified a dated system with many complaints in need of an upgrade.
