

Project Limits – Janisch Road to the North, Judiway Street to the South, North Shepherd Drive to the East, and Ella Boulevard to the West

- Start Construction = October 10, 2016
- Anticipated Completion Date = July 7, 2018
- Construction Cost = \$19,658,776.00

Installation of drainage and associated pavement including:

- Storm Sewer
- Sidewalks
- •Curb ramps
- Underground utilities
 - Water Lines
 - Sanitary sewer lines
- Traffic Signal (blue circle)
- Street lighting

Project length = 1.3 miles














PHASING PLAN

- Will my street be at a different elevation that it is today?
- What about any school buses that typically drives on the affected streets?
- On streets under construction, what is the procedure for trash and recycling pickup?







Questions – Sidewalks, Trees & Lighting

- What about my sidewalk?
- What about our trees?
- What about landscaping near streets, sidewalks and curbs?







Questions – Restoration

- How can residents feel comforted that all restoration will occur properly?
- What about my driveway?
- What if I have an improved or special/decorative driveway and/or walkway?
- What if I perceive that there has been damage to my property?
