


CIP No. N-100012

This Capital Improvement Plan project is on Hillcroft between Beechnut and Bissonnet. It has been funded and starting design in 2016 with construction planned for late 2018. Proposed reconstruction in this segment includes expansion from four to six lanes between Edith and Bissonnet Streets, 6-foot sidewalks and intersection improvements at Bissonnet and Beechnut. Underground storm sewer, sanitary and water lines will be replaced as necessary. Limited right-of-way acquisition may be needed to improve turning movement at Bissonnet and Beechnut intersections.




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HILLCROFT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT
