


South Gessner: Richmond to Buffalo Bayou (CIP Number N-100017)

This Capital Improvement Plan project is funded and began design in 2016 with construction scheduled for 2019. The project proposes full reconstruction between Richmond and Westheimer to include: 6-foot sidewalks; new street pavement with lane expansion from four to six lanes; median reconfiguration; intersection improvements at Richmond and Meadowglen; and storm, sanitary and waterline improvements as necessary. Improvements between Westheimer and Buffalo Bayou will include: limited panel replacement; full reconstruction and improvements to the Briar Forest intersection; access management at median openings to allow for improved traffic mobility and increased turn lane capacity at Westheimer and other intersections as necessary. All trees identified by ordinance will be protected, relocated or replaced as required. All work will be conducted within existing right-of-way.
