






Wynnewood Acres Area — (CIP number M-410014)

This Capital Improvement Plan drainage project is funded and starting design in 2016 with construction tentatively planned for 2019. All streets and driveways up to right-of-way will be reconstructed with concrete pavement. The project will increase the capacity of the storm drainage system by replacing existing ditches with pipe and swale system. Water and wastewater will be replaced as needed. Per design standards, 5-foot sidewalks will be included on all streets. All work will be within existing right-of-way.




WYNNEWOOD ACRES AREA Reconstruction
